13. Class order of go will be posted for pattern classes on the Friday before each show. Please be ready at the gate when your number is called. If rider cannot be located after a reasonable number of attempts by show staff they will be dropped to the bottom of the order to keep the class running expeditiously.
14. All show patterns will be posted online before each show.
15. Entries will close Thursday at 10pm before each show. No late or same day entries will be accepted. Cash and Check payments for pre-entries are accepted at the office on show day.
